Permit Application

Conditions for Permit to Sell Paintings in Todd Mall

Permits are available to individuals only. This permit only entitles the holder to sell paintings; a painting being defined as a depiction on canvas, linen, paper or other similar material.

Permit cost is \$200 per year (from date of issue), but permits may be issued for a period of 3 or 6 months (\$50 and \$100 respectively). Payment must be provided at time of application. Photo ID must be presented when applying. The permit card will contain a photo image of the holder. The permit will negate the requirement for a separate ASTC Market Stall Licence.

Council reserves the right not to issue a permit to any applicant.

As desired by the Uniting Church (the landowner), it will be stated on the permit that this activity occurs with their permission in order that the area be viewed as a place of reconciliation.

Conditions:

1. Selling is limited to the grassed area of the Uniting Church, specifically excluding the pathways, verandahs and areas under eaves.
2. Permit holders may only sell paintings produced predominantly by themselves. If, in the opinion of an authorised officer, a painting for sale has not been predominantly produced by the permit holder, the painting must be removed from sight and not offered for sale again.
3. No structures may be erected on the lawns.
4. All by-laws must be observed by the permit holder and others in the vicinity associated with the permit holder.
5. There is to be no touting or other forms of solicitation.
6. The period of permitted activity is between 9AM and 7PM.
7. The permit holder must not take up an area greater than 2m x 2m.
8. No area is reserved; space is available on a first come first served basis.
9. Activity is not allowed during authorised market periods without a permit from the market organiser (a fee may be payable).
10. The permit holder must carry their permit card with them when selling artwork and must provide it for inspection when requested by an authorised officer.
11. The ASTC may, at any time, for any period and without notice, close the area or any part thereof, to the selling of paintings for any purposes of Council or at the request of the Uniting Church.

Any breaches of these conditions may result in the permit being immediately and permanently revoked with no refund.
