Enrolment

Payment is to be made in full at the time of enrolment. All fees are non – transferable and non-refundable.

Re-Enrolment

All students must re-book for each term. Please refer to the Learn to Swim Calendar for enrolment dates.

Discounts

Discounts apply to families with 2 or more children. Second child will receive a 5% discount and third or children thereafter will receive 10% off the term fees.

Vouchers

We accept all \$100 NT Government and Water Safety Awareness Program (WSAP) vouchers. Vouchers must be provided at time of booking if they are to be used for the current term or lodged in the family account as credit for future use when received.

Changing Lesson Times/Days

Change of lesson times and days is subject to availability and must be done at reception via email to lts@asalc.com.au in person or phone 89504366

Change of swim levels

Change of swim level needs to be approved by the LTS Team Leader in consultation with instructor.

Teacher Changes

ASALC will make the best attempts to ensure consistency of instructors throughout the term. However, no guarantees can be given.

Infant/Toddler Lessons

Parents are required in the water with their child for all Wonder 1 - 4 classes. The ages can vary between 6 months to 5 years.

ASALC Cancellation

Any cancellation of lessons by ASALC will automatically be credited back into the family account.

Family Cancellation

Credits will only be considered under the following guidelines

- Injury/illness
- Other extenuating circumstances.

Medical certificates must be received or adequate documentation provided. All approval for credit is at the discretion of the LTS Team Leader.

If for any reason you are unable to commit to the term, we recommend not enrolling in the program and returning the following term. Any missed lessons due to holidays, work related events, religious reasons or general illness without a medical certificate will not warrant a credit or refund.

Privacy Statement

Make up Lesson policy:

- All participants will receive a maximum of 1 make up lesson per term for a lesson being missed whatever the reason being.
- Make-up lessons MUST be taken within the term of missed lesson
- Bookings for make-up lessons need to be made by contacting lts@asalc.com.au
- If you cancel or fail to attend your make-up lesson this lesson will then be forfeited
- Families are eligible for make up when and /or call us/ email in advance – prior to their usual class start time

SWIM READY & POOL SUPERVISION RULES

Swim Ready Policy

As per our swim ready Initiative all students must:

- Wear their coloured wristband received on entry
- Visit the toilet or be wearing an aqua pants (infants & toddlers)
- Shower before entering the pool

If you or your child has had diarrhoea or vomiting in the past 2 weeks, please do not swim.

Pool Supervision Rules

- Children 0-5 years & non swimmers; parents must be within arm's reach at all times.
- Children 6-10 years & weak swimmers; parents must be close and be prepared. Parents should be in the water and maintain a visual contact with their swimmers.
- Children 11-14 years; must be check on by a parent/ guardian regularly.

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

To respect the privacy of all visitors any video, camera or recording equipment is not to be used in ASALC to record anyone other than the immediate friends or family of the person recording. Additionally:

- Cameras or other recording equipment are not to be used in the change rooms or underwater at any time.
- It is an offence to record video or pictures of the general public without their prior consent.
- It is an offence to post photos on social media that have general public in them who are not known to you, without their prior consent.

If Alice Springs Aquatic & Leisure Centre staff have concerns that your photography could be in breach of the above conditions, they may ask you to stop taking any photos for the remainder of your visit.

Learn to Swim Emergency Action Plan (E.A.P)



Please follow the Emergency Action Plan (E.A.P) below in the event of an emergency at the Alice Springs Aquatic and Leisure Centre.

After 3 whistles heard or asked by Lifeguard to evacuate



Swimming Instructor will remove class from water
Children are to stay with their swimming instructor and evacuate as a class immediately to the evacuation point (as directed by staff)
You do not have time to collect your belongings



Continue to follow directions of Lifeguard/Centre staff
Stay with your child/ren's swimming instructor and class



Upon being given "All Clear" by Senior Lifeguard you may re-enter the centre and lessons will continue

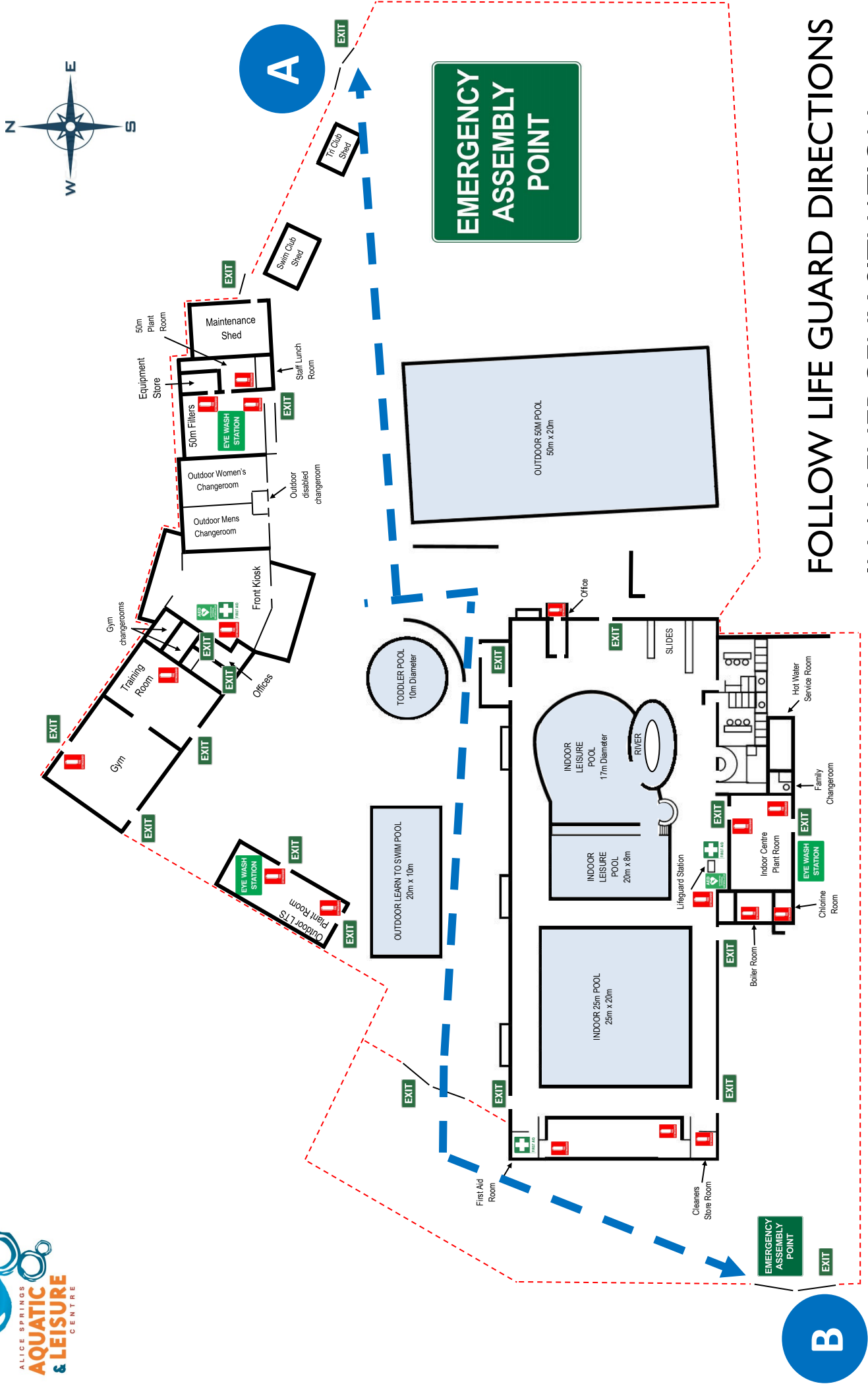
