

Candidate information sessions

Alice Springs Town Council will hold four information sessions for members of the public considering nominating in the upcoming 2021 Local Government elections.

Alice Springs residents will head to the polls on 28 August to elect the 14th Alice Springs Town Council with nominations opening on July 16.

In conjunction with the NT Electoral Commission, two sessions will be held on both Tuesday 6 July and Wednesday 7 July in order to give interested residents information about the election process and the role of a Councillor in Alice Springs.

“Elected Members play a crucial role in shaping the direction of our town it’s important to give potential candidates as much information as possible to help them serve the community of Alice Springs,” ASTC CEO Robert Jennings said.

“These information sessions will give all potential candidates a good foundation of knowledge. You certainly don’t have to be a lifelong Centralian to stick your hand up and nominate.”

Each session will feature information both from the Alice Springs Town Council and the NT Electoral Commission.
