Matt Paterson will become the 10<sup>th</sup> Mayor of Alice Springs when officially sworn in on 29 September, 2021.

Mayor Paterson served as part of the 13<sup>th</sup> Council and held the position of Deputy Mayor for two years. Mayor Paterson will be joined in the Chamber by Jimmy Cocking, Eli Melky, Mark Coffey, Marli Banks, Steve Brown, Kim Hopper, Allison Bitar and Michael Liddle after being elected as Councillors.
