

Electoral Signage guideline update

Alice Springs Town Council wishes to advise the community that it has updated the Council Guidelines for Election Signage in Public Places.

CEO Robert Jennings said "Council is responding to community concerns on this matter and has now brought our policy in line with other relevant documentation on the matter."

"These policies are now aligned with Northern Territory Government and Rangers are working on the implementation of this."

Key amendments include:

- No placement in Council trees.
- The timing of signage display has is in line with Northern Territory Government policy of 6 weeks out from Election.

Council has published these guidelines on Council's website and made contact with all relevant parties on this update. As of 17 July 2020 these guide lines are in effect.
