Alice Springs Town Council is inviting community feedback on the following open community consultations.

Current Council Consultations:

<u>Council Smart Tree project</u> - This piece of community infrastructure provides real time data and intelligence to Council to enable better management of public spaces. Council is seeking the views of the community on concept designs. Council has installed a prototype at Frank McEllister park, this prototype is not the final design for the trees however, will provide Council with valuable information towards the next stage of development and expansion of the trees across the community. <u>Jim McConville Oval Sports Field Lighting</u> – Council has been approached by local sporting groups to install field lighting at Jim McConville Oval in Gillen.
