Alice Springs Town Council partners with EqualiTea

Alice Springs Town Council is proud to announce its partnership with EqualiTea on a disability inclusive employment initiative, offering appropriate employment for people with disability.

Mayor Ryan said, "Council is very excited about this partnership as it's a win-win-win – a win for the Council as the employer, a win for the new employee, and a win for the local community."

EqualiTea is a training employment and activities Social Enterprise for people with disability and is coordinated by NT Friendship & Support Inc.

The initiative commenced in November 2019 and will be a 12 month trial program. Alice Springs Town Council is proud to partner with EqualiTea in providing a program that assists people with disability gaining meaningful employment.

EqualiTea's CEO Stephanie Ransome said, "The program is about working with employment providers such as Alice Springs Town Council towards getting people with disability into appropriate, inclusive employment."

"Council's EqualiTea employees have their own uniforms so the community can identify and support them in their on-the-job training with supporting Employment Engagement Assistants. So, if you see one of the friendly Council EqualiTea crew out and about on their daily rounds, give them a wave," said Mayor Ryan.
