Sports Facilities Master Plan public consultation open

Alice Springs Town Council would like to advise that the community consultation period for the 2019-2029 Sports Facilities Master Plan has now opened.

“As Alice Springs sports needs continue to grow, Council is keen to gain the community’s input to foster the future direction of our sports and facilities” said Mayor Ryan.

The Sports Facilities Master Plan enables planning for the future growth of respective sports within the community and upgrading/development of Council-owned and managed facilities, including ovals, pitches, fields and stadiums.

Residents are encouraged to complete the online survey on Council’s website – www.alicesprings.nt.gov.au/consult before 5pm Friday 14 June 2019. There will also be a specific survey sent to sporting clubs and organisations.

Residents are invited to attend a public meeting regarding the consultation at 5.30pm Thursday 16 May 2019 in the Andy McNeill Room at the Alice Springs Town Council Civic Centre on Todd Street. There will also be a sports summit to engage local sporting groups.

The Sports Facilities Master Plan 2019-2029 is a ten year plan and the consultation period will close by 5pm Friday 14 June 2019.
