5.1 Public Art Master Plan & Action Plan

The Acting Manager Community and Cultural Development advised the printed Public Art map was launched in September, in conjunction with Desert Festival. Two public art walks with the local artists were also held this year.

5.2 PAAC Budget (Standing Item)

Director Corporate Services advised that Council officers are currently working through the budget line items. There were some purchase orders that were incorrectly put to PAAC budget, which has put the budget into negative.

5.3 <u>TIO Traeger Oval Wall Mural</u>

The Acting Manager Community and Cultural Development advised that first half of the paneling to correct the peeling mural will be installed by the contractors in December.

5.4 Art in Parks EOI

Elliat Rich was selected to move to stage 3 of the design development stage of the project. The chosen park was Lyndavale Park.

The artist will be presenting their Stage 3 design development to PAAC meeting in February 2022.

5.5 Many Hands Art Centre Iltja Ntjarra Metal Works

The purchase of the five Ilta Ntjarra (Many Hands) Art Centre steel works will be installed along the walkway structure in Hartley Street carpark. The five panels have been covered with anti-graffiti protection.

There have been some delays in installation as Council officers are still waiting for the installation quote from contractors.

The mural at the ASALC facility has been installed and completed.
