Temporary Australian Disability Parking Permit for an Individual – Conditions of Use



1. The following regulatory authorities apply to this application:

- **3.** The Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Power of Attorney and Medical Practitioner must read, and understand the conditions of use of the permit.
- **4.** A Temporary Permit cannot exceed 12 months at a time. The permit will not be renewed on expiry. If another permit is required, a new application form must be completed.
- **5.** The Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Power of Attorney must keep a record of the permit number as we do request permit numbers for a reprint. Only 1 re-print will be allowed.

6. Displaying the permit:

- > The Permit must only be used when the vehicle is being used to transport the Permit Holder.
- > The Permit only needs to be displayed when parking under the above conditions.
- > The Permit must be displayed inside the windscreen or hung from the rear-view mirror.
- > The Permit number and expiry date must be visible from the exterior of the vehicle.
- If the permit is hung off the rear-view mirror then it must be removed before the vehicle is in motion to avoid obstructing the view of the driver.

7. The permit:

- Is valid if the vehicle is being used to transport the Permit Holder.
- Allows the vehicle to be parked in parking spaces that are signposted and have the people with disabilities symbol painted on the road surface.
- > Do not exceed any parking sign time limits applying to a parking area for people with disabilities.

8. Concessions:

- If there are no parking bays for a person with a disability the following concessions will be made on other *parking bays*:
 - Twice the period indicated on signage.
 - E.G. 15 minutes extends to 30 minutes, 1 hour extends to 2 hours, 2 hours extend to 4 hours
- After the concessions time is over normal parking restrictions apply.
- Please note: If the parking sign is in an area set aside for people with disabilities, the additional parking concessions do not apply.

9. Caution:

- ➤ If the Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Power of Attorney allows misuse of the disability permit allocated to the Permit Holder to take place, this can lead to the Permit being revoked and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
- ➢ If it has been found that the Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Power of Attorney and Medical Practitioner has provided false and misleading information or details, this can lead to the application being rejected and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
- ➤ If it has been found after the issue of the Permit that the Applicant/Parent/Guardian/Power of Attorney and Medical Practitioner has provided false and misleading information or details, this can lead to the Permit being revoked and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
