### 7.1 Sponsorship Application – FABAlice 2022

Dale McIver having declared an interest in Item 7.1, left the meeting at 4:38pm prior to discussion of this matter. This Item was discussed after Agenda Items 7.2 and 7.3 to allow Dale's participation in the meeting, however, it was recorded as per the Agenda sequence.

FABAlice Festival is seeking financial sponsorship of \$20,000 to assist with the physical marketing presence in the CBD (banners, flyers), the staging in the Mall of the free community concert on the Friday night and costs associated with the staging of sub events over the weekend. The event will be held from11 to 13 March 2022.

The event received \$15,000 sponsorship from Council last year, \$10,000 in 2019 and \$10,000 in 2018. In-kind support each year was also provided to total cash equivalent of \$3,000. Council's ability to host the night market to coincide with the 2022 FABAlice event will cost \$6,000.

Discussion ensued about the application in terms of the remaining Committee budget, total value of the event, in-kind support from Council and the benefits it will contribute to the Alice Springs community.

That Council support the application from FABAlice Festival Inc to the value of \$10,000 (incl. GST) for the FABAlice event to be held from 11 to 13 March 2022.
