Guidelines for Banner Display in Alice Springs



Alice Springs (Management of Public Places) By-laws 2009.

Banner Structures:

There are five different banner structures to display banners.

For Horizontal Banners:

- On the Corner of Larapinta Drive and the Stuart Highway.
- Gap Road between Traeger Avenue and Speed Street.

For Horizontal Banners Complete - Application for A Public Places Permit for a Horizontal Banner Display.

For Flag Banners:

- Light Poles on Barrett Drive, Leichhardt Terrace and Wills Terrace. These flags have different design requirements to the Bannerconda CBD Light Pole System.
- ➤ Bannerconda CBD Light Poles on Gregory Terrace, Parson Street, Hartley Street, Todd Street and Wills Terrace. These flags are attached with a pulley system and require a different design from the Light Pole Flags.

For Flag Banners Complete - Application for A Public Places Permit for Flag Banner Display.

Each of these structures has different requirements and banner sizes, please read the requirements below before sending in an application form.

For all Banners:

The Alice Springs Town Council reserves the right to refuse permission for a banner display on any grounds, especially if the banner contains:

- An offensive image, message or language.
- It incites any form of hatred, aggression or violence.
- Political content.
- Is unlawful under local, territory and federal law.

Please apply first for the permit to ensure there is space available for the dates required. A banner application must have a copy of a current Public Liability Certificate attached.

If there are multiple events for the same activity throughout the year then please attach a separate list of all dates required.



1] Banner Structure on Larapinta Drive/Stuart Highway:



Location:

- Corner of Larapinta Drive and Stuart Highway.
- There are eight spaces for banners on the structure. Banners must be made according to the below sizing.



Banner Size & Recommended Design:

- Length 3.8 metres and Height 1.3 metres. Please do not exceed this sizing.
- Sturdy material with wind holes and reinforced eyelets to combat strong winds.
- Ties to attach the banner to the structure. No Padlocks are to be used.

Responsibility of the Permit Holder:

- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to install and remove the banner as per the dates on the permit.
- > If the banner is damaged or has come loose, it is the responsibility of the permit holder to rectify it.
- The permit holder may not remove or move another banner that is on the structure.
- > The Alice Springs Town Council does not allocate any of the 8 spaces available on the structure to any specific event/activity, the permit holder will install the banner where there is space available on the installation date of the permit.


- For an event/activity that is 1 day up to 1 week 2 weeks before the start date and period of the event will be booked.
- For an event/activity that is 2 weeks or more only 4 weeks will be allowed in total. If your event/activity is 4 weeks or more, please indicate which <u>consecutive</u> 4 weeks you would like to book. Council may consider up to 6 consecutive weeks on written request.

2] Banner Structure Over Gap Road:



Location:

> Gap Road, between Traeger Avenue and Speed Street.



Banner Size & Recommended Design:

- Length 11 metres and Height 1.5 metres. Please do not exceed this sizing.
- Sturdy material with wind holes and reinforced eyelets to combat strong winds.
- A cable or very strong rope is to be attached across Gap Road to each pole. The banner will then be attached to this.

Responsibility of the Permit Holder:

- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to install and remove the banner as per the dates on the permit.
- A contractor must be used, as they have the correct equipment and Traffic Management Procedures to perform this task. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure the contractor used is compliant with Traffic Management regulations.
- If the banner is damaged or has come loose, it is the responsibility of the permit holder to rectify it.

- For an event/activity that is 1 day up to 1 week 2 weeks before the start date and period of the event will be booked.
- For an event/activity that is 2 weeks or more, only 4 weeks will be allowed in total. If your event/activity is more than 4 weeks, please indicate which <u>consecutive</u> 4 weeks you would like to book.

3] LIGHT POLES:



This is not the same as the CBD Light Pole Bannerconda System.

Barrett Drive – 21 Available Leichardt Terrace – 2 Available Wills Terrace – 8 Available

Banner Size & Recommended Design:

- Width 1 metre and Height/Length 3 metres. 75 cm Sleeve/Hem at the top of the banner. 3 Reinforced eyelets for ties on one side of the banner to secure the banner to the pole.
- Sturdy material and reinforced eyelets to combat strong winds.

Responsibility of the Permit Holder:

- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to install and remove the banner as per the dates on the permit.
- A contractor must be used. They have the correct equipment and Traffic Management Procedures to perform this task. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure the contractor used is compliant with Traffic Management regulations.
- > If the banner is damaged or has come loose, it is the responsibility of the permit holder to rectify it.

- For an event/activity that is 1 day up to a 1 week 2 weeks before the start date and period of the event will be booked.
- For an event/activity that is 2 weeks or more, only 4 weeks will be allowed in total. If your event/activity is more than 4 weeks, please indicate which <u>consecutive</u> 4 weeks you would like to book.

4] CBD LIGHT POLE BANNERCONDA SYSTEM:



This is not the same as the Light Pole Banner System.

Wills Terrace 2 Available


Todd Street 5 Available (From Stott Terrace to Gregory Terrace)

Responsibility of the Permit Holder:

- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to drop off the banners at the front counter of the Civic Centre at 93 Todd Street on the drop-off date indicated on the permit. Please have the banners stored in an enclosed box/container.
- The Alice Springs Town Council install and remove the banners, and will endeavour to install and remove them as per permit dates. Emergencies or mitigating circumstances may result in the delay of installing or removing the banners or re-attaching a loose banner.

- For an event/activity that is 1 day up to 1 week 2 weeks before the start date and period of the event will be booked.
- For an event/activity that is 2 weeks or more, only 4 weeks will be allowed in total. If your event/activity is more than 4 weeks, please indicate which <u>consecutive</u> 4 weeks you would like to book.
